

MAGNAFLOW RECOMMENDS PROFESSIONAL INSTALLATION ON ALL THEIR PRODUCTS

ATTENTION: Always install any supplied band or U-bolt clamps to the proper torque specifications of 40-45 ft-lb for band clamps and 30-35 ft-lb for U-bolt clamps. Over tightening will result in the clamps breaking and will NOT be warranted by MagnaFlow.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS





Step 1. To remove the OE exhaust system begin by loosening the clamps at the outlet of the catalytic converter and the inlet of the muffler. With the exhaust supported disengage the welded hangers from the rubber insulators and remove the system. Do not damage or discard the rubber insulators as they will be install the MagnaFlow system.



Step 2. Begin installation by attaching the Inlet Pipe Assembly to the outlet of the catalytic converter using the supplied 2.50" clamp and fitting the welded hanger into the rubber insulator (Leave all clamps and fasteners loose for final adjustment of the complete system.)



Step 3. Next, attach the Extension Pipe Assembly and the Muffler using the supplied 3.00" clamps and engaging the hanger into the rubber insulator.

Step 4. Attach the Driver and Passenger Over Axle Pipes to the Muffler Assembly using the supplied 2.50" clamps and engaging the welded hanger.



Step 5. Finish the installation by attaching the Tail Pipe Assembly to the Over Axle Pipes using the supplied 2.50" clamps and fitting the hanger into the rubber insulator.



Step 6. Once a final position has been chosen for the new exhaust system, evenly tighten all clamps from front to rear using the torque specifications on page one of the instructions. Inspect all fasteners after 25-50 miles of operation and re-tighten if necessary.
